#### Reports from the Chief -

Chief Mercer – We had 32 calls in June. 12 EMS, 19 Fire and 1 HazMat. Rookie Perkins has passed her final exam. We will be welcoming her into the Firefighter rank. We are reviewing policies and working on those. Rookie academy will finish at the end of next month. Extrication class will be at Axis August 13. August 13 be the Fire1 Practical, August 27th will be the Live Fire Practical. Talking with West Routt, they will be sending one of their firefighters to join for the live fire and practical. E3 was on a call on Bakers Peak and broke the mirror brackets on the doors. Reached out to McCandless today, pricing should be around \$2000. R1 has a Kussmaul enroute. Batteries are here, waiting to install after the Kussmaul arrives. L1 – Continuing talks with Max Fire. Email from the tech indicated in process of repairing a portable compressor and will be updating us

next week. Rosenbauer is sending a tech in August. The door combo locks are not satisfactory. Returns have been authorized. Looking into other options. We put the simplex locks back on the tower, and ordered a single lock to try on the main door, then we will proceed. ESO data migration call was on Monday, scheduling work, looking at go live September 1. Looking at creating task books to be implemented. As an option to keep training up to speed. The DFPC is here today. Live fire simulator is here, pumping simulator, driving simulator just arrived, getting set up for tomorrow. We did not see as many numbers as anticipated. There will be classroom class at the station Saturday, and 4 classes at the tower starting tomorrow at 5. The luau is finalized with a date of August 20<sup>th</sup>, 6:00 pm at The O.P. Bar and Grill. Talking about updating the event for next year. Hose testing is scheduled for September 24<sup>th</sup>. Budget 2023 is in discussion. Have the previous paperwork, updating letterhead. Contacts have changed for the City and County. Will get requests done by the end of the month. Department photos are outdated. Previous photographer no longer in business. Purchased backdrop. Working on a date for new photos. We have had pretty good luck with department members cooking, need volunteers for August or December, would the Board like to cook a meal?
